

**DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
VARIOUS ROADS WARMSWORTH DONCASTER
PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC/ONE WAY
TEMPORARY ORDER 2011**

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD
TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991**

NOTICE is hereby given that Doncaster Borough Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 because works are being or proposed to be executed on or near the roads and the effect of the Order will be to prohibit all vehicles proceeding in that length of road described in Part (1) of the Schedule to this notice and introduce One Way traffic system on that length of road as described in Part (2) of the Schedule to this notice on the dates and at the times referred to in the said Schedule.

Reason for closure:- To ensure the safety of the public and the workforce whilst work is being carried out to the carriageway.

NOTICE is given that the Provisions of the Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads, Doncaster) (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 2009 are suspended in respect of a One Way Traffic Order for Wrightson Avenue that extends between the Edlington Lane and the A630 Sheffield Road for the duration of the works and only whilst physical works take place in this length of road.

NOTICE is also given that the alternative route for vehicles affected by the Order is via A630 High Road, Warmsworth Road, Hall Flat Lane, Springwell Lane, Broomhouse Lane and vice versa.

NOTICE is given that the Provisions of the Doncaster Borough Council (Various Road, Doncaster) (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 2009 are suspended in respect of a One Way Traffic Order for Cecil Avenue that extends between the A630 Sheffield Road and Edlington Lane.

The Proposed Order will continue in force up to and including the 26th day of June 2011 or until the works which it is proposed to carry out in or near the said road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

SCHEDULE

Locations

Part One

(1) Edlington Lane, Warmsworth from a point immediately south of the junction with Low Road West in a southerly direction to a point immediately North of the entrance to Warmsworth and Edlington Spiritual Church, to include all those roads that form a junction with Edlington Lane, between Low Road West and the Church entrance.

(2) Lords Head Lane at its junction of Broomhouse Lane.

Part Two

Introduce a one way section of road on Low Road West, from its junction with Edlington Lane in an easterly direction for a distance for a distance of 35 metres.

Times and Dates

Between 07.00 hrs to 19.00 hrs commencing Sunday 6th February 2011 and then for a series of consecutive Sundays up to and including 26th June 2011 or until works are completed.

Edlington Lane will be closed for the duration of the works. Advanced notice of each restriction will be advertised by signs erected on site at least 6 days in advance.
